## Call for Entries awards program, Midwest Construction's **Best of 2005**

Submission Deadline: September 2, 2005

**Midwest Construction** is seeking entries for its annual award program dedicated to honoring the best projects and the companies that design and build them in Illinois, Indiana, Wisconsin and Eastern Missouri.

An independent jury made up of industry leaders in real estate, design and construction will judge the projects in a number of different categories. The winners will receive full coverage in the December 2005 issue of Midwest Construction. In addition, the winning teams will be honored at an awards ceremony in January 2006.

### Criteria

1. Projects must be built in Illinois, Indiana, Wisconsin or Eastern Missouri.
2. Submitted projects must be completed at any time in calendar year 2005 to be eligible.
3. Size is NOT a criteria – submit the smallest, most delicate renovation project, or the multi-million dollar project.
4. There is no limit to the number of submissions allowed per submitting company.
5. Send all your best projects in any or all of the attached categories.
6. There is no entry fee.
